

## Community and Student Engagement

TEC 39.0545, as part of House Bill 5

■ Requires each district to evaluate the district's performance and the performance of each campus in the district on community and student engagement (8 factors) and in policy compliance

■ Requires each district to assign itself and each campus a rating of exemplary, recognized, acceptable, or unacceptable for both overall performance and each evaluation factor:

- Fine arts
- Wellness and physical education
- Community and parent involvement
- 21st Workforce development program
- Second language acquisition
- Digital language acquisition program
- Dropout prevention strategies
- Educational programs for Gifted/Talented Students
- Compliance with statutory reporting and policy requirements

Using the 2016-2017 District Improvement Committee composed of community members, staff and parents, the following ratings were determined:

Ganado ISD - Recognized

Ganado Elementary - Recognized

Ganado Junior High - Acceptable

Ganado High School - Recognized
